Bicycles:

The college is located at the heart of the city making it easy for students to commute by bicycles.

Public Transport:

Andhra Christian College is centrally located and on the main road, easily accessible to public transport network. Most of the students, teachers and non – teaching staff use public transport. The railway station is located within 5-10 minutes walking distance from the College. A number of students walk to college. Autorickshaws are available on a sharing basis to drop off students within walking distance of the college.
