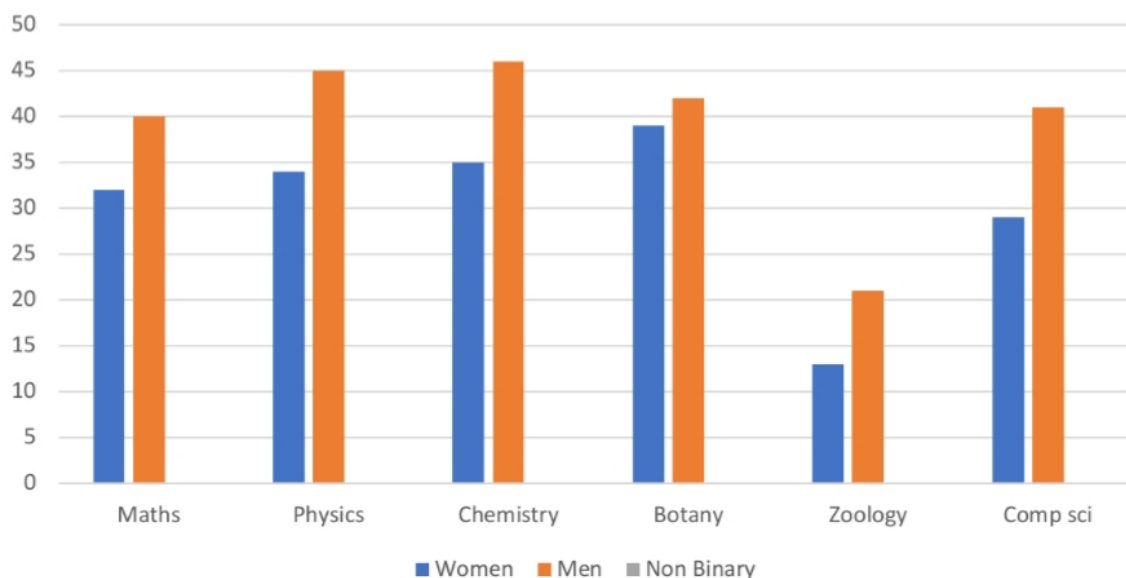

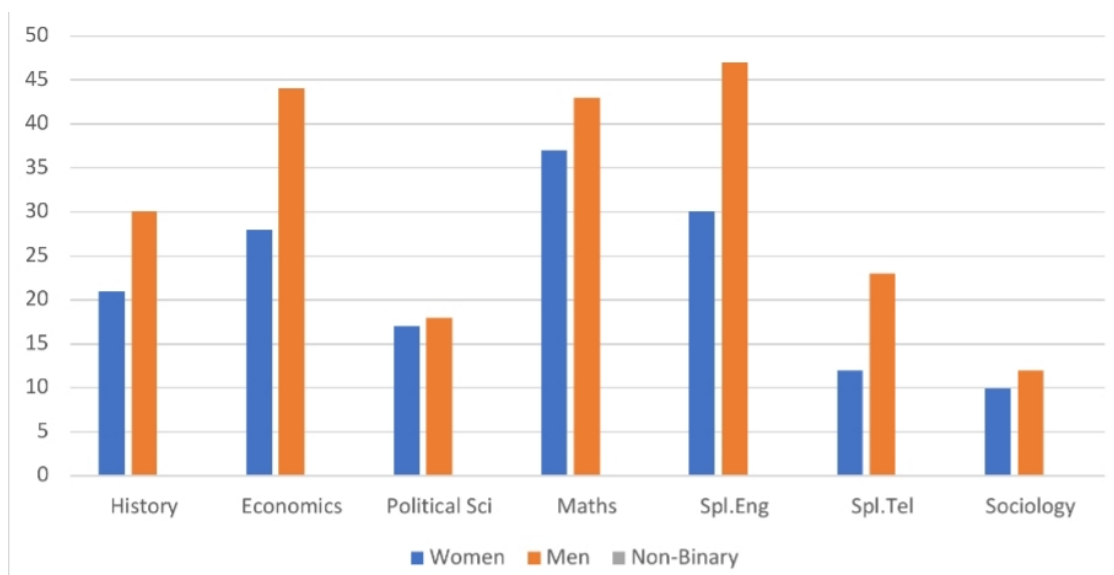
Gender Audit for 2022-2023 was conducted in order to analyse the gender gap prevailing in the campus. The concluding analysis is as follows

Gender Variation in Bachelor of Sciences during 2022-23



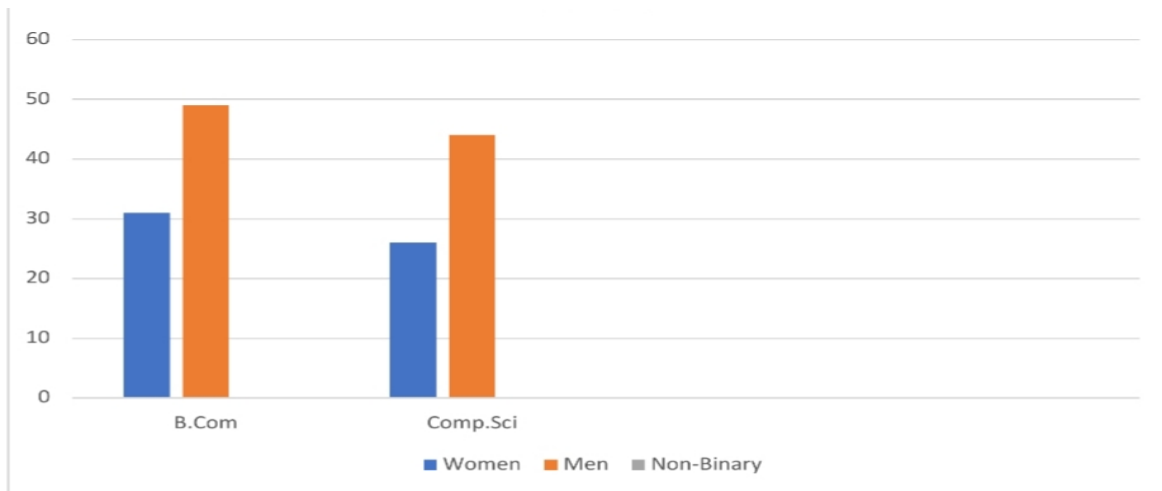
The above analysis shows the strength of boys more than that of girls in B. Sc courses, but the strength of girls has increased compared to previous records.

Gender Parity in Bachelor of Arts during 2022-2023



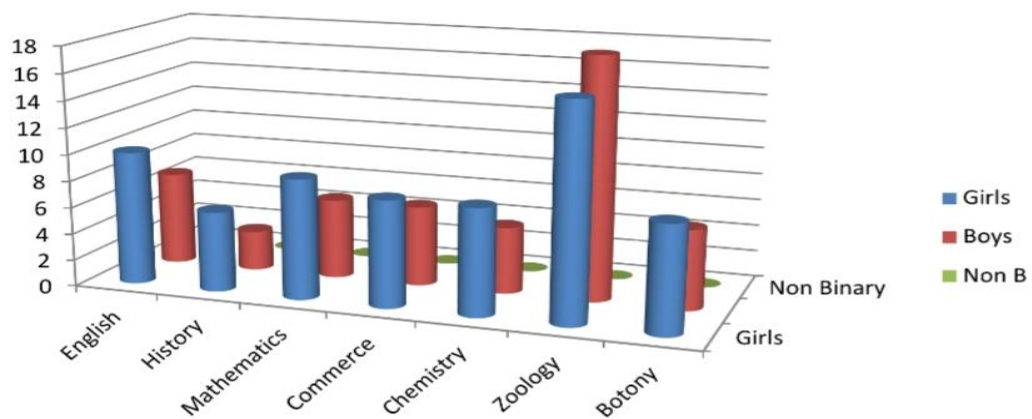
The above chart shows that the number of boys is comparatively higher than that of girls in the Arts courses.

Gender Parity in Degree Commerce streams -2022-2023



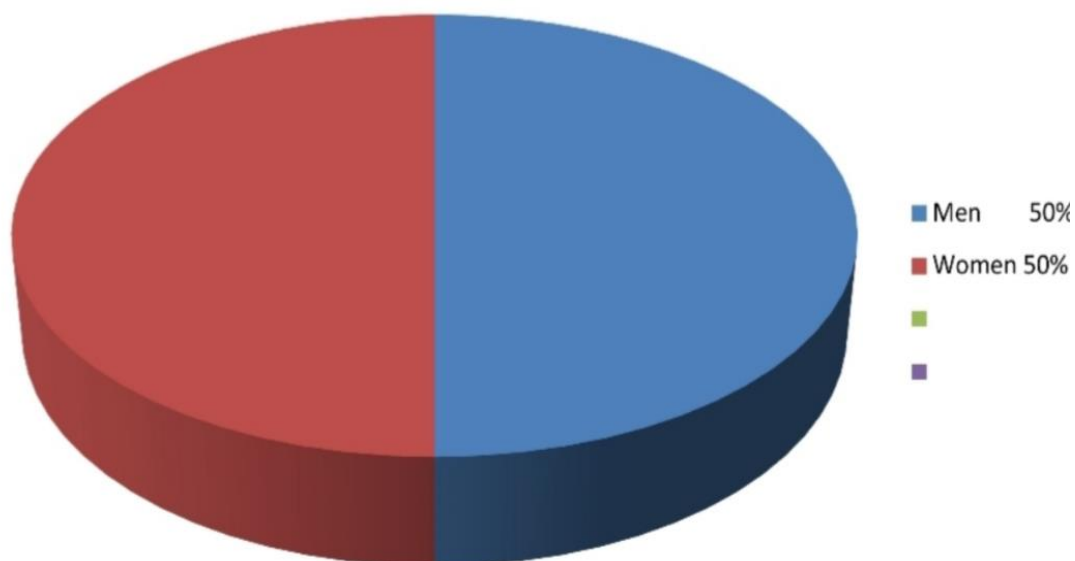
The above graph shows the strength of boys higher than the strength of girls in the Commerce sections.

Gender Parity in Post-Graduate Courses



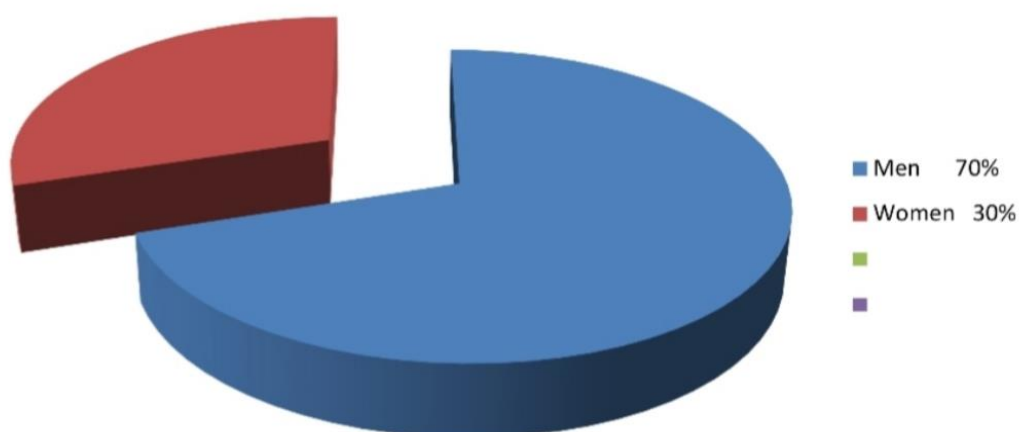
The above graph shows higher number of girls in the Post Graduate Courses. As against the U.G. Courses, the number of girls are more than that of the boys.
